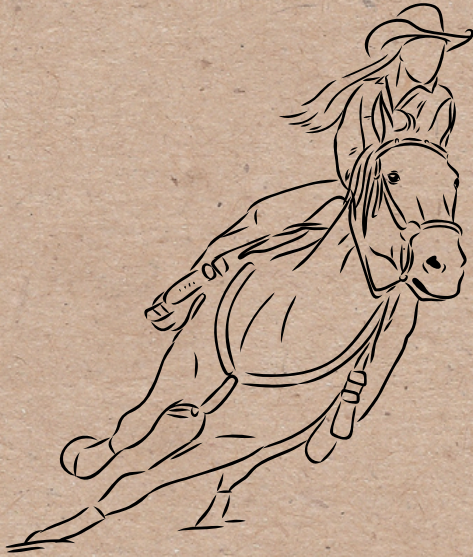

NO EXTRA COSTS

TO BE ELIGIBLE

- Must be a CRCA financial member before the first participating rodeo
- Must compete (Ladies Barrel Race) in all three (3) participating rodeos
- The time from each participating event will be added together to provide an aggregate time
- The fastest aggregate time of the eligible competitors at the end of the series will be the winner



NOVICE HORSE OF THE YEAR

NOVICE BARREL HORSE OF THE YEAR:

- THE STATUS AT THE START OF THE YEAR MUST BE DECLARED AS A NOVICE HORSE THROUGH THE CRCA OFFICE WITH NOVICE HORSE DECLARATION FORM FILLED AND SIGNED. THE HORSES STATUS AT THE END OF THE YEAR CAN BE EITHER NOVICE OR OPEN, SO LONG AS THE HORSE STARTED THE SEASON AS A NOVICE.
- ONLY HORSES THAT HAVE BEEN RIDDEN IN THE SEASON BY FINANCIAL MEMBERS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE END OF YEAR AWARD.
- ONLY FINANCIAL MEMBERS ARE ABLE TO VOTE ON ELIGIBLE HORSES FOR THE AWARD. VOTING WILL CLOSE BEFORE (TIME TBA) THE PRESENTATION OF END OF YEAR AWARDS.
- THE VOTED NOVICE BARREL HORSE OF THE YEAR WILL RECEIVE TROPHY BUCKLE AT THE END OF YEAR PRESENTATIONS, A TROPHY LEVY WILL BE ADDED TO NOVICE HORSE ENTRY FEE.

JUNIOR SUPER SERIES RULES

To be eligible

1. Must be a Current CRCA financial member before the start of the series.
2. Must ride in all 3 events
3. Day members can ride in the events but will not be eligible for any series points
4. Competitor with aggregate highest points over the 3 rounds will be crowned the series winner.
5. Points will be awarded up to eighth place.
6. If the points are tied after the 3 rounds, we will go to a shoot-out and the highest marked junior bull ride or fastest junior barrel race will be crowned the Super Series Champion.

• \$1500 + add back prize money per event per rodeo.
 Series champions receive buckle and \$500 bonus payout.
